
Dear Kindergarten Families,

Tomorrow we begin our distance learning. This is new to all of us and we will be learning with you. Some important things for you to know are listed in this letter, so please save this.

- Students are required to sign in to the attendance link emailed every day.
- Students are required to complete two or three learning activities from the flex board each day.
- Have a container with the school supplies that were sent home to use during this learning time (crayons, markers, pencils, etc.).
- Every Monday morning you will receive your weekly grade level newsletter via email. The first one will be sent out tomorrow, March 30. Use this for your child's learning each week. There will be links and other information to help with home instruction.
- The worksheets included in student bags are not specific to upcoming instruction. You can use them as needed, and many can be used for Word Work activities.
- You may contact ANY kindergarten teacher during office hours. We purposefully selected time blocks throughout the day in order to match up with parents' differing schedules. Your child's teacher will still be available throughout the day via email and Google Meet. Here are directions on how to access Google Meet:
